Your Son/Daughter will need to bring his/her own personal equipment. The following list is a guide; it is not an exhaustive list. All items must be packed in a rucksack/kit bag. Bin bags are NOT suitable

1.	Participants MUST travel to and from the Camp/Holiday in uniform including top and group neckerchief		
2.	Black bin bags are not suitable for carrying sleeping bags as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit.		
3.	Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name.		
4.	Please label items with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your Sons/Daughters Name.		
5.	No games or gadgets which require batteries to run. No mobile phones. There will be no charging facilities.		
6.	No Jewellery – stud earrings only
