



## Chamboree Kit List(Suggested)

## Weekend - Cubs, Brownies

Your Son/Daughter will need to bring his/her own personal equipment. The following list is a guide; it is not an exhaustive list. All items must be packed in a rucksack/kit bag. Bin bags are NOT suitable

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Uniform top and Group neckerchief. (wear in transit)	Sleeping Bag
1x Shorts, 2x Trousers/leggings (No jeans / skirts)	Pillow
2x T-shirts or Similar	Camp blanket
1x Warm Sweater/fleece/hoodie	Carry mat / bedding roll
Underclothes	Cuddly toy (well behaved ones only)
Socks	Torch and Spare Batteries (not wind up type)
Pyjamas	Pen and small notebook
Coat	Cake in a named box to share for pudding/snack
Waterproofs (top and bottom)	Personal Wash Kit / Sanitary products
Sun hat, warm hat and gloves	Personal medication
Hike Boots/Wellies + 2x welly sticks (e.g 24" bamboo)	Lip salve, sun cream and Insect repellent – name labelled
Trainers	Tuck shop / souvenir money max £5
1 hand Towel	Small Game/Book
1 Tea Towel	water bottle
Polythene Bags to Separate Clean/Dirty/wet Items	Plain white T-shirt for tye-dye
Pirate clothing and accessories (eye patch, bandana etc)	Swimming kit and old clothes/pumps for water activities
General Notes  1. Participants MUST travel to and from the Camp/Holiday in uniform including top and group neckerchief	
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- 2. Black bin bags are not suitable for carrying sleeping bags as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit.
- 3. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name.
- 4. Please label items with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your Sons/Daughters Name.
- 5. No games or gadgets which require batteries to run. No mobile phones. There will be no charging facilities.
- 6. No Jewellery stud earrings only
- 7. Purchase of sweets in the tuck shop will be limited to a set amount per visit to ensure that meals are eaten. Suggested maximum amount £20 in a named wallet/purse with owner's name. No sweets or chocolate to be taken to camp please.
- 8. All medications to be clearly labelled with child's name and dosage instructions, to be handed to a leader on arrival.
- 9. Benches will be provided to sit on no need to bring a chair for the weekend

## **Optional - Pocket Knives (age 11+ only)**

Knives must be of the folding type, must not "lock" in the open position, and must not have a blade exceeding 3" in length. Knifes to be held by leaders when not in use. Please transport these inside the kitbag / rucksack to and from camp.
