General Notes

1. We would ask that your Son/Daughter travel to and from the Camp/Holiday in uniform.
2. Black bin bags are not suitable for carrying sleeping bags as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit. Please use a stuff-sac and place the sleeping bag inside the rucksack where possible, or use a heavy duty plastic bag.
3. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name.
4. Please label items with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your Sons/Daughters Name.
5. No games or similar items which require batteries to run please.
6. Purchase of sweets in the tuck shop will be limited to a set amount per visit to ensure that meals are eaten. Suggested maximum amount £5 in a wallet/purse with owner's name. **No sweets or chocolate to be taken to camp please.**
7. No mobile phones please ... its only a weekend to be offline!
