Black bin bags are not suitable for carrying sleeping bags as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit. Please use a stuff-sac and place the sleeping bag inside the rucksack where possible, or use a heavy duty plastic bag. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name. 3. 4. Please label items with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your Sons/Daughters Name. 5. No games or similar items which require batteries to run please.

- 6. Purchase of sweets in the tuck shop will be limited to a set amount per visit to ensure that meals are eaten. Suggested maximum amount £5 in a wallet/purse with owner's name. No sweets or chocolate to be taken to camp please.
